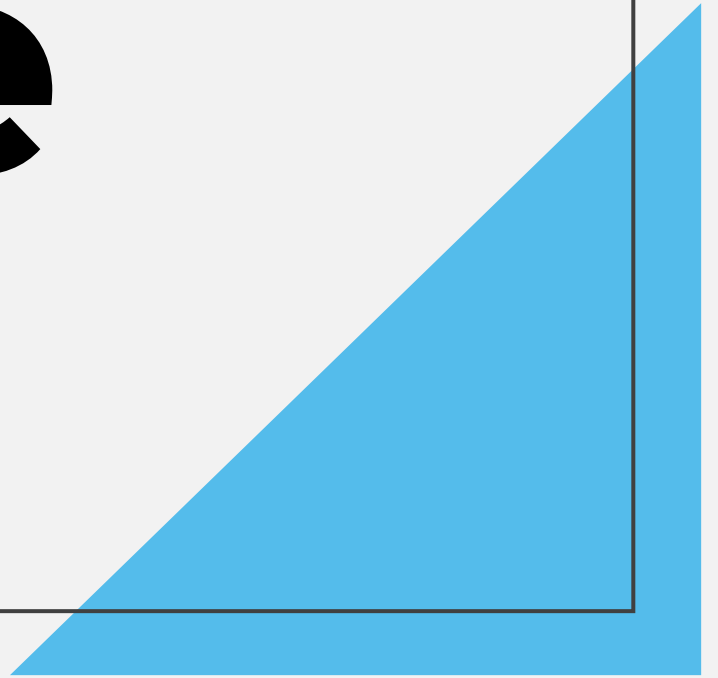

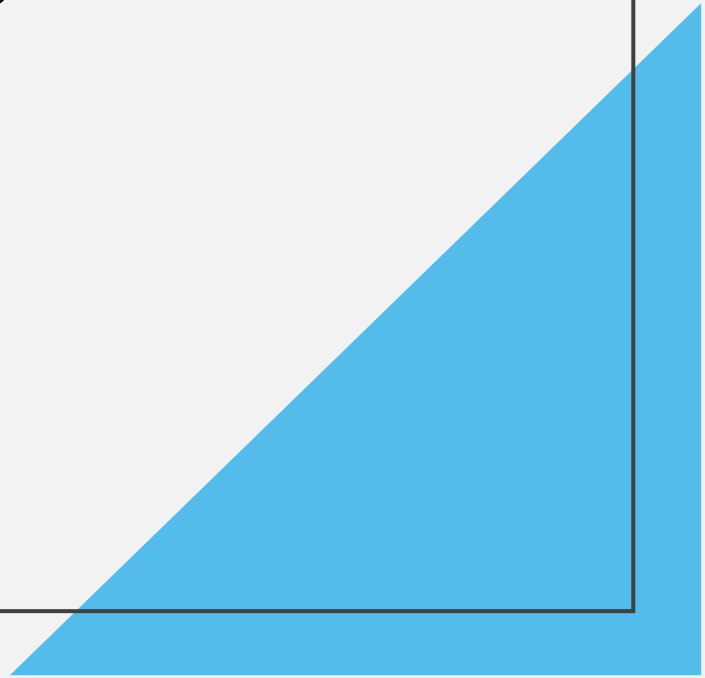

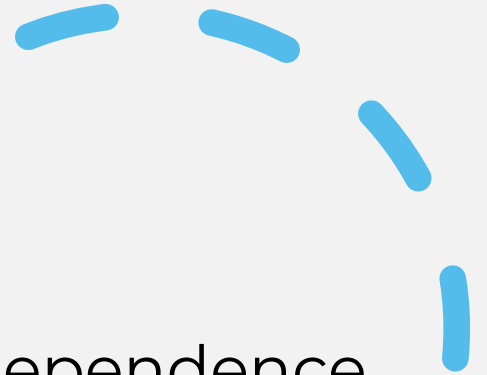

- Teach your child that in life we all experience ups and downs.
- Talk to your child about the opportunity to make new friends and discuss that friendships may change.



Getting ready for secondary school

- **Every day counts!**
(unless your child is unwell or for family reasons)

When your child misses just...	that equals...	which is...	and therefore, from Kindy to Year 12, that is ...	This means that the best your child can achieve is...
1 day each fortnight	20 days per year	4 weeks per year	Nearly 1½ a years of school	Equal to finishing Year 11
1 day a week	40 days per year	8 weeks per year	Over 2½ a years of school	Equal to finishing Year 10
2 days a week	80 days per year	16 weeks per year	Over 5 years of learning	Equal to finishing Year 7
3 days a week	120 days per year	24 weeks per year	Nearly 8 years of learning	Equal to finishing Year 4

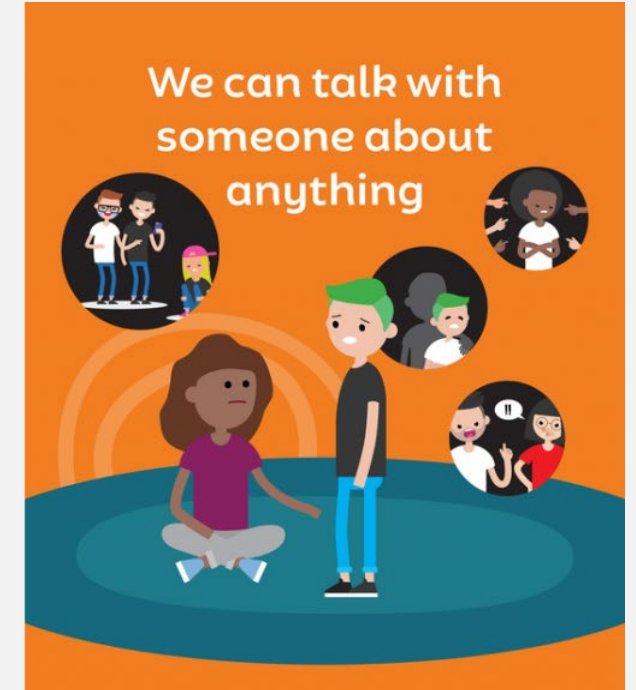
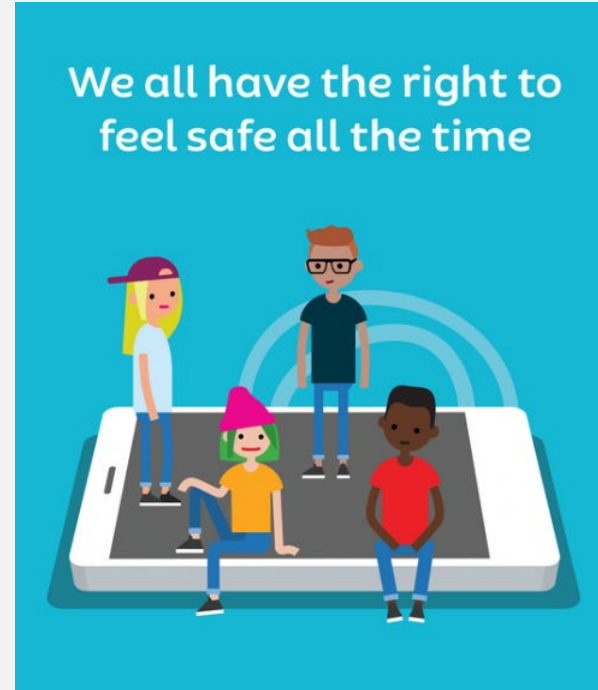

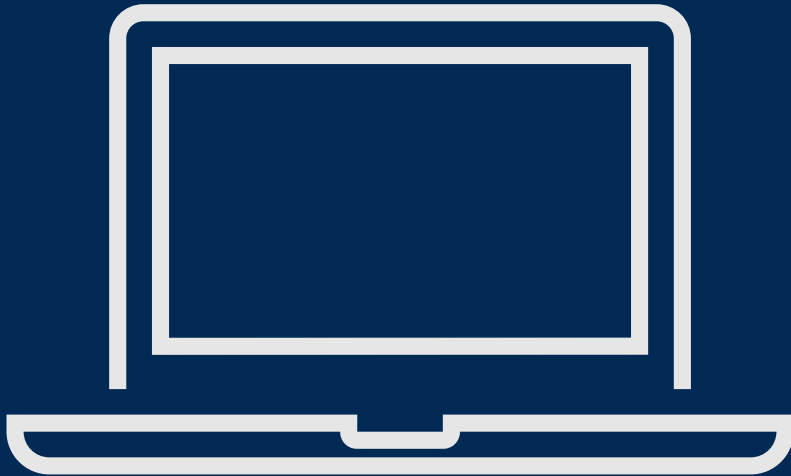

Student Expectation

- Laptop to be brought to school everyday
- To be fully charged

Loan Laptops

- Provided to students with hardware issues (with a note from parents)
- 2-week renewable loan period

Internet Usage

- Controlled and monitored through a Firewall
- Certain applications are not permitted to be used on the College network and will result in the students being locked out of the network for a couple of minutes, e.g. Social Media, Skype, Bittorrents.

Digital technology plays a pivotal role within education, with the benefits of advancements in technology forming a significant part of a student's learning environment.

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

Students enrolled at Kennedy Baptist College require a portable computer which meets the College's minimum specifications. To ensure that the best possible experience is provided to our students, the technological operating environment on campus differs from that outside of the College or at home. For this reason, it is essential that the required device specifications are understood and met to ensure your child's device will function whilst at the College.

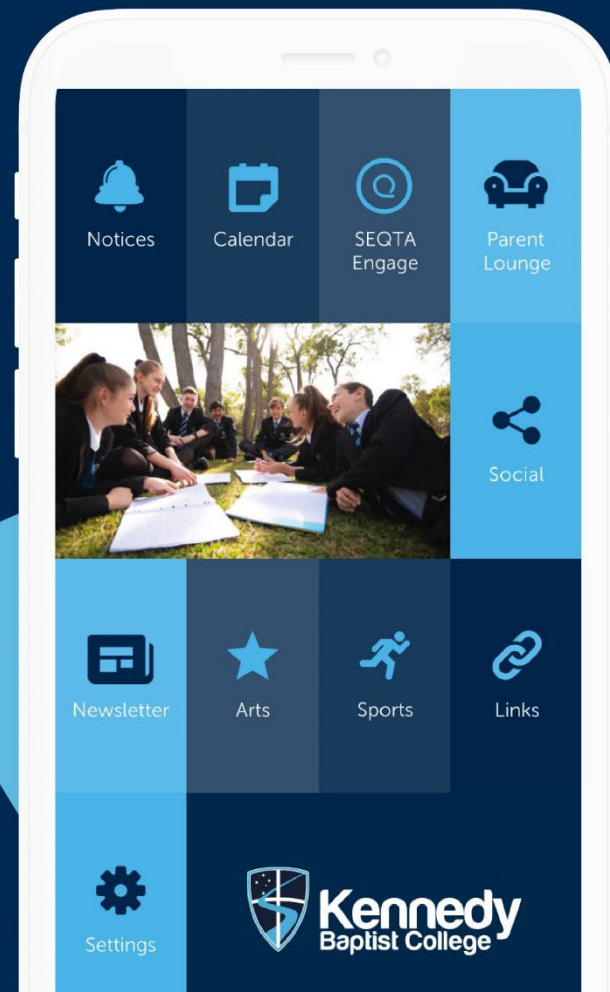

The mobile app for notices, newsletters, Kennedy Handbook, policies, useful links and quick access to SEQTA and Parent Lounge.

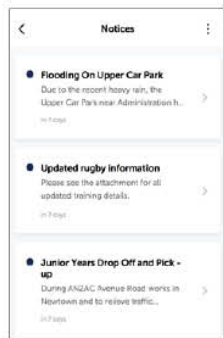
Term Dates

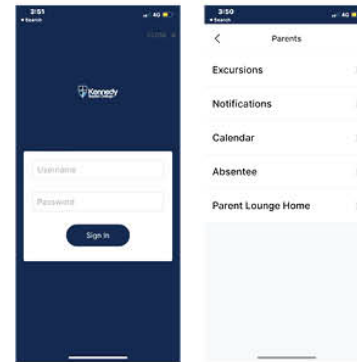
SEQTA Engage

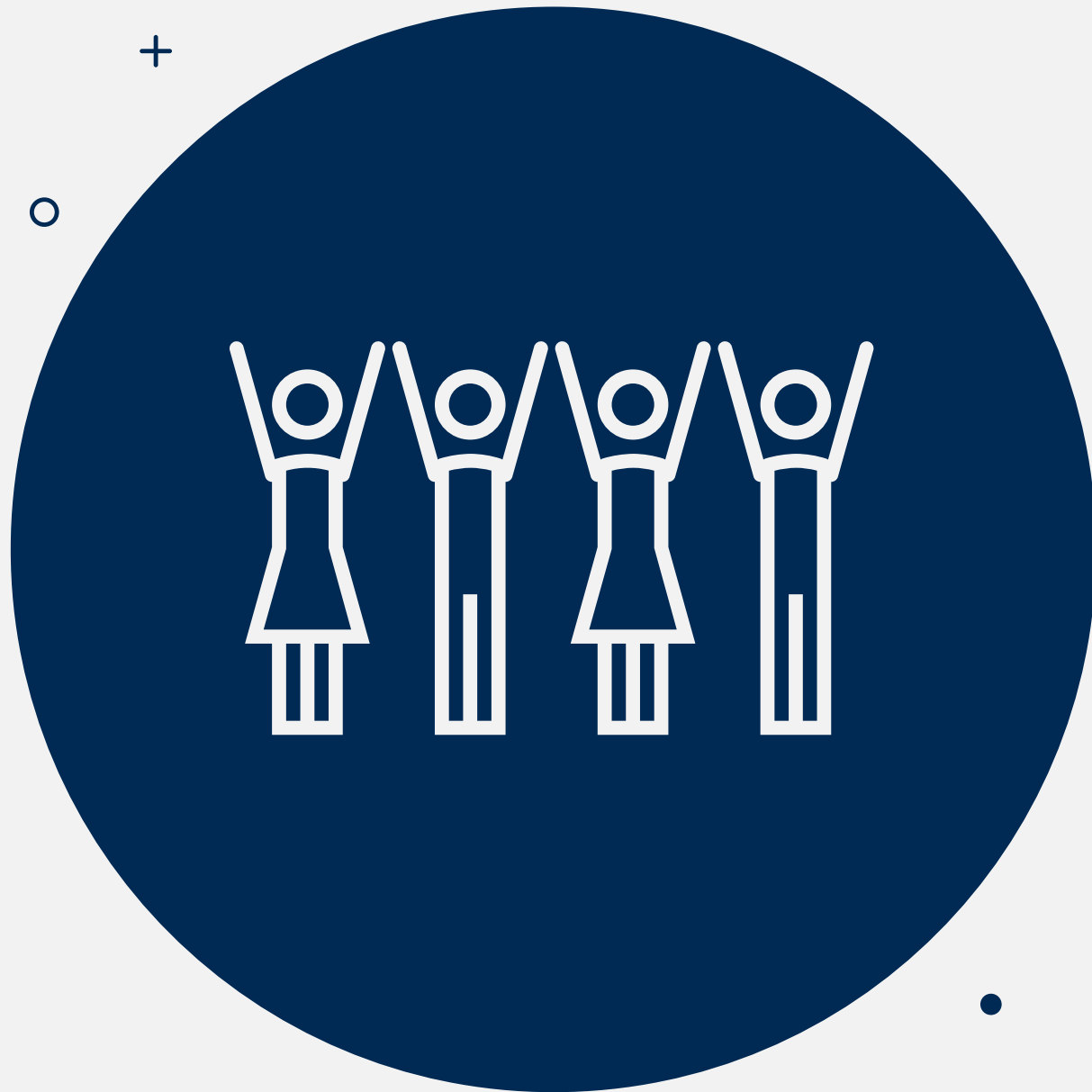

Routines, rules and rewards

- **Uniform Policy**

- No mobile phones are to be used from 7:45am-3:15pm
- Rewards: House Points for community, academic and uniform. Each term there are prize draws.
- Lost property: Located in the Student Services.



School bag

- Label school and sports bag clearly
 - Label school clothes and classroom materials.
 - To minimize the amount of textbooks to carry from class to class, upload the eBooks to their devices and keep the textbooks at home for revision.
 - Lockers with ample space are provided for each student.
 - Encourage a clean-out at the end of each week.

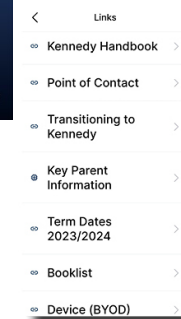
