Dear Parents, Guardians and Students

Following the announcement from the Premier last night (28June), Kennedy will be open for the remainder of this week and the timetable will run as normal with face-to-face delivery of the curriculum. Restrictions are in place to ensure a safe environment for all members of our community. Visitors are not permitted on campus for the lockdown period.

Masks are required to be worn by all College staff and students at all times. Teaching staff are permitted to remove their mask if teaching to enable clear enunciation.
