Dear Parents/Guardians

From Friday, 14 October, COVID-19 mandatory isolation requirements will be removed. This change was agreed to at National Cabinet and further information will be provided later this week.

Current settings remain in place until midnight Thursday 13 October. Please visit healthywa.wa.gov.au for up-to-date COVID-19 related support and advice. Students on work placement and work experience, and staff who visit these students, will be required to follow any public health restrictions and testing and isolation protocols applicable to their work placement site.

All of us have an important role to play in supporting a healthy community by following the advice outlined on healthywa.wa.gov.au. At Kennedy, we continue to urge families to keep their child at home if they are unwell and notify us via the normal absentee processes (Parent Lounge, email, or phone absentee line) if they have tested positive for COVID-19. In preparation for their return to school, they can access their coursework via SEQTA as their health allows.
